Richmond Hill Baptist Church Vision Statement:

Growing Disciples – Discipleship is a lifelong process of becoming more like Christ like that results in helping others come to and grow in Christ. (Matthew 28:19-20, Colossians 2:6-7)

Passionately Participate - We believe that God has uniquely gifted each person for whole hearted service throughout the various stages of life. (Matthew 22:37-39, Romans 12:7-8, 11)

Following Christ - Collectively our church and community will be transformed to the degree that individuals choose to follow and live for Christ. (Luke 9:23, Matthew 4:19, 2 Corinthians 5:15)
