What to Expect When You Arrive Age 3 – Grade 6

Check-In Process (Fellowship Hall / Base Camp)

When entering a classroom the children are invited to participate in a variety of engaging activities during the duration of the check-in period. The activities are designed for the leaders to interact with the children while creating an enjoyable learning environment, and easing any separation anxieties that they may experience. The adult checking the child into the classroom is given an identification label that is necessary to release the child at the end of the service hour.

Curriculum

We believe even our littlest ones can learn! Our core curriculum is from the Lifeway Sunday School Series (see www.lifeway.com for more information). We begin each Sunday together at Base Camp (in the Fellowship Hall) where the children will enjoy a game, songs, and interactive story including puppets to help introduce the main concept for the day. Following the 15-20 minute group time, the children depart to their class (divided by ages) for more instruction, fellowship time, and crafts.

Check-Out Process

Richmond Hill requires an adult to pick up their children from class. Be sure you check with a leader to determine the final pickup location for your children (maps a provided).
